Annual FSTP CoP Meeting, 8 – 9 November 2023



#### Meeting highlights

- Second live meeting
- 45 live and 18 online participants
- Exchange of regional and country practices
- Peer-to-peer learning concept
- Active involvement of participants as key speakers, facilitators, and contributors to the report
- New ideas on how to foster ownership and community engagement









#### Main topics

- Monitoring of FSTP grant contracts
- VAT practices and challenges
- Reaching smaller organisations with simplified application and reporting procedures;
- Development of inclusive selection criteria to reach out to more CSOs who have limited experience and financial capacity
- Presenting the gender mainstreaming checklist – what has been learned from experience
- Communication and visibility aspects of the FSTP grant beneficiaries









#### Key conclusions

- Further work on the **simplification** of procedures is needed.
- Regular meetings with grant beneficiaries are important to receive timely feedback.
- Gender-sensitive perspectives should be visible in all aspects of the project design.
- Strengthening of capacities in the assessment process is needed.
- Capacity building of grant beneficiaries in finance management and communication and visibility is needed.









#### Key recommendations

- To introduce **national FSTP Focal Points**.
- Active involvement of CoP members in the design and implementation of future events.
- To support national-level activities (i.e. Webinar on VAT exemption procedures).
- To establish working groups on specific topics (i.e. simplification of procedures).
- Capacity building of FSTP implementors to further transfer knowledge to grant beneficiaries (i.e. Communication and visibility requirements of EU-funded grants).
