

### What is Erasmus+?

- The EU's programme to support education, training, youth and sport
- Funding for programmes, projects and scholarships
- Fosters intra-European (among the 33 E+ countries) and international cooperation
- North Macedonia, Serbia and Türkiye are fully associated to E+ (as well as Iceland, Lichtenstein and Norway)

## Erasmus+ International dimension: Heading 6 funding

### Capacity Building for Higher Education

- Develop and adapt curricula, in terms of content and teaching/learning methods
- Support university-enterprise cooperation
- Work on upskilling of academic and administrative staff
- Reform of governance and management systems at national, regional or HEI level
- Foster internationalisation of universities in research, scientific and technological innovation
- Introduce Bologna-type reforms at institutional, national or regional level
- Develop new approaches and tools for policy making and monitoring

#### CB HE – Some key features

#### Application via EACEA

Applicant is based in EU Member
States and associated countries or in
eligible third countries not associated to
the Programme

Duration: 2 or 3 years

EU grant per project: Min 200 000 € - Max 1 000 000 € Three types of project with different budget ranges:

- FOSTERING ACCESS TO COOPERATION IN HE (24-36 months): smaller scope projects focused on universities & LDCs – priority to newcomers
  - 2. PARTNERSHIPS FOR TRANSFORMATION IN HE (24-36 months): larger-scale projects focused on innovation, university/business and governance
  - 3. STRUCTURAL REFORM PROJECTS (36-48 months): focus on policy reforms require involvement of ministries



## Capacity Building on Vocational Education and Training

They aim to support the relevance, accessibility, and responsiveness of VET institutions and systems in third countries **not associated to the Programme** as a driver of sustainable socio-economic development.

Build capacity of VET providers to strengthen cooperation between private and public stakeholders in the field of VET for demandoriented and opportunity-driven VET interventions;

Improve the quality and responsiveness of VET to economic and social developments to enhance the labour market relevance of skills provision;

Align VET provision to local, regional and national development strategies



#### CBVET – Main features

Applicant is based in EU Member States and associated countries



Duration:1, 2 or 3 years

EU grant per project: Min 100 000 € - Max 400 000 €

### Capacity Building in the field of Youth

#### **Objectives**

- Support social engagement, solidarity and cross-border mobility
- Develop youth work in non-associated third countries
- Promote non-formal learning
- Ensure that young people have tools to take part in society.

EU grant per project: Min 100 000 € - Max 300 000 €



## Capacity Building in Sport

#### **Objectives:**

- Raise grassroots sport organisations capacity
- Support practice of sport and physical activity
- Promote social inclusion through sport
- Promote positive values through sport (fair play, tolerance, team spirit...)
- Foster cooperation across different regions of the world through joint initiatives.

Duration: 1, 2 or 3 years EU grant per project: Min 100 000 € - Max 200 000 €

Applicant is based in EU Member States and associated countries or in eligible third countries not associated to the Programme


